Jensen Meat Company Est 1899 / P5897, is aware of FDA Bioterrorism regulations. However, we are strictly regulated by USDA and Jensen Meat had implemented and validated a Food Defense Plan.

Please note that per CFR 21 1.226 Registration of Food Facilities will not apply to facilities that are regulated exclusively, throughout the entire facility, by the US Department of Agriculture under the Federal Meat Inspection Act (21 U.S.C. 601 et seq) and the Poultry Products Inspection Act (21 U.S.C. 451 et seq).

Our Food Defense Plan has been developed and implemented and monitored in compliance with USDA – FSIS Directives. Our Plans are reviewed annually by USDA, and vulnerability assessments are conducted by USDA every 2 years. Web-based risk mitigation tools are also available to Jensen Meat Company. USDA Directives are consistent with FDA, as appropriate and possible.

Jensen Meat is registered with the US Food and Drug Administration pursuant to the Federal Food, Drug and Cosmetic Act as amended by the Bioterrorism Act of 2002 and the FDA Food Safety Modernization Act.
